The open kitchen in the great room has stone and stainless steel accessories, and the dining area stands beside floor-to-ceiling windows. The top level is devoted to a dramatic master bedroom that includes a custom wardrobe, ribbon-flame fireplace and spa bathroom with steam shower and a soaking tub.
