

Approachable elegance awaits in remodeled Kings Mountain Midcentury

There's something to be said for being surrounded by wilderness yet still having access to a chef's kitchen, surround sound and a soaking tub.

"In the lap of luxury, yet surrounded by nature — it's an irresistible way to live on the mountain," said **Barbara Dunlap** of **Pacific Union Real Estate**, who is listing 13250 Skyline Blvd. in Woodside for \$1.98 million.

Built in 1966, the fully updated three-bedroom offers an open floor plan and modern materials. Ceiling speakers and contemporary lighting fixtures offer creature comforts in the great room's living area. An open kitchen is finished with a subway tile backsplash, a stainless steel farmhouse sink and plenty of counter space.

Two fireplaces warm the sunny interior graced with wide-plank hardwood flooring. One sits below the great room's built-in media center, while the other awaits within the den/office.

"Relaxed elegance oozes throughout this home," Dunlap said.

Thoughtful inclusions over the years ensure the landscape is equally enticing.

Multiple decks and patios await within the gated lot, as a hammock suspended above the rear lawn beckons with the promise of afternoon catnaps. Nearby, a hot tub flanked by trees serves up a secluded space for stargazing.

A sliding glass door off the dining area opens to a view deck, and the office accesses a deck all its own.

Single-story design ensures no one is climbing stairs after a day of hiking or cycling along Kings Mountain. Paver stones form a sprawling driveway with ample space for friends and family to park their cars.

French doors in the kitchen lend direct access to the heart of the home from the driveway. Of course, there's also a front door embellished with stained glass that projects a more formal introduction.
